

2010 GRANT WRITING WORKSHOPS

Our Grant Writing Workshops are geared to help people learn how to write the narrative information on a grant application (often the most daunting part) and the difficult art of finding the right grant for their project. Many times people are told what grants they could apply for, but they are too intimidated to complete an application, or do not know where to find information about available grants. These workshops are designed to help people through those challenges.

- Workshops are open to tourism suppliers such as festival organizers, program chairpersons for various community organizations, Main Street organizations, Chamber of Commerce staff, libraries, museums, and city and county governments. Beautification planners, community leaders and other tourism stakeholders are also encouraged to attend.
- There is a maximum of 15 people per class. Please do not ask to have two people attend per one registration.
- Content will include research for the right grant and the basics of writing a good application, narrative and proposal.
- Participants receive a three-ring binder manual to take home when finished.
- Registration is \$75 per person (space is not reserved until registration form and fee is received.) Registration for only a portion of the workshop is not accepted.
- The workshops are two days: 10 am – 4 pm the first day, 9 am – 3 pm the second day. Everyone is expected to attend both days.
- Meals will be on your own.
